Relics of Blessed Martyr Priest Jerzy Popie<sup>3</sup>uszko ( HYPERLINK "[http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Jerzy\\_Popie%C5%82uszko](http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Jerzy_Popie%C5%82uszko)" \t "\_blank" [http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Jerzy\\_Popie%C5%82uszko](http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Jerzy_Popie%C5%82uszko)) has been introduced into Franciscan Basilica of St. Louis the King in Katowice on Sunday, February 27th.

We introduced two reliquiaries: one for the Basilica and the second for the Knight's Templar Priory in Poland.

The Pontifical Mass has been said by HE Bishop Józef Kupny and 7 concelebrants, among whom there were Father Dymitr Zeglin, OFM, Guardian of the Monastery and Father Alan Rusek, OFM, Parson.

In the end of holy mass the Bishop blessed all the people with relics and one of the reliquiaries has been officially transferred to Knights Templar into my own hands.

Eight Polish Knights Templar took part in this historical event for whole Order of all obediences.

After the mass we ate lunch together with Lord Bishop, our families and Franciscans of the Convent in Monastery's refectory hall.

This was probably the first official transfer of relics of Catholic Saint or Blessed to Knights Templar since suspension of our Order by Pope Clement in 1312!
